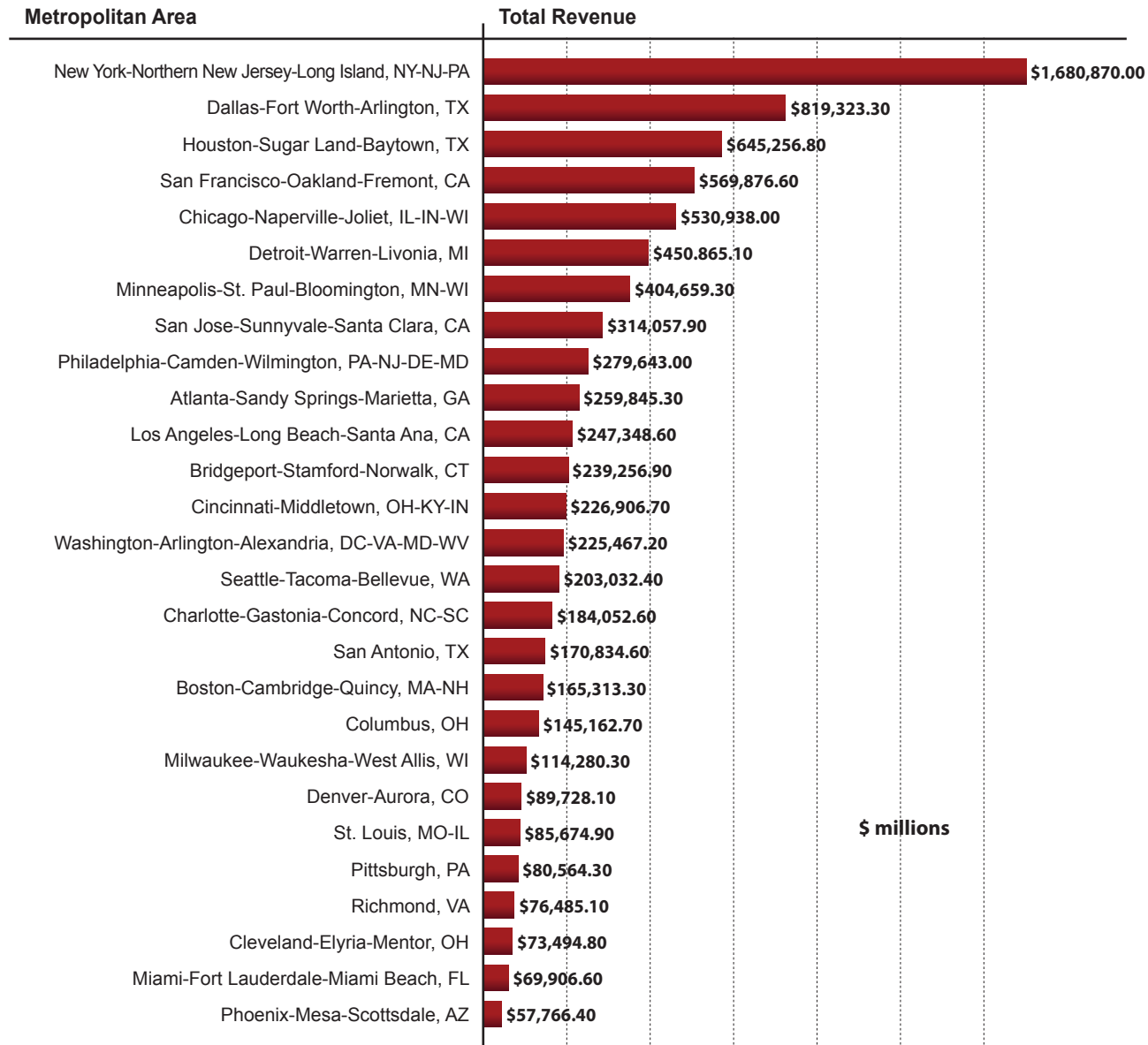

(2009 Total Revenue in millions)**

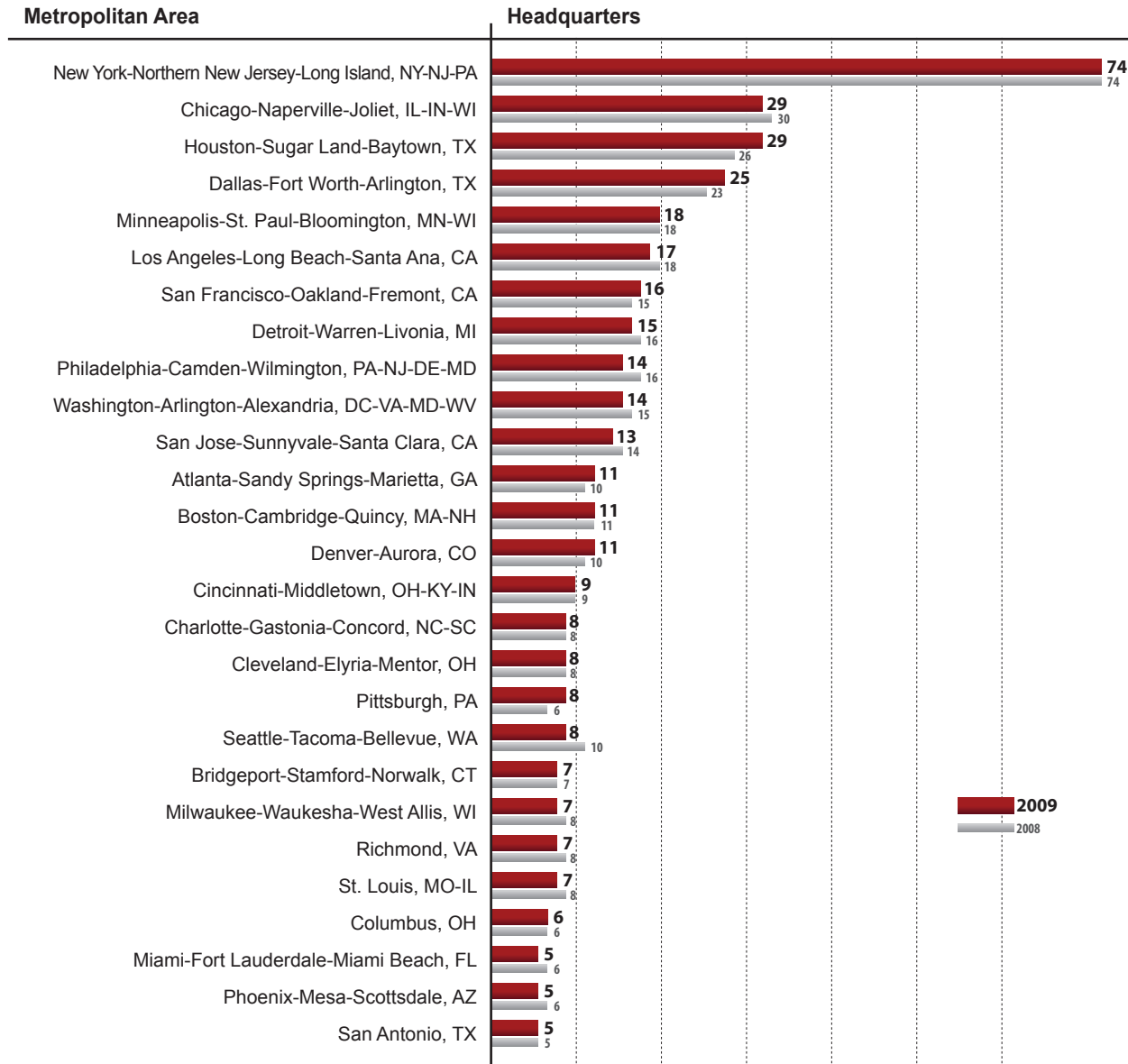
